Cultural Celebrations

Christmas Show Rehearsals

We have been very busy in October preparing for our annual children's Christmas show. Water Explorations

Some encouraging warmer days at kindergarten has prompted the return of water explorations especially in the water trough and sandpit. The children have wasted no time in getting engaged in some self made muddy puddles, an activity that has been revisited frequently. **Spontaneous** activities like this are truly valuable in early childhood with skill development and learning in areas such as gross motor development,

hand-eye coordination, maths concepts such as measurement and volume and social skill development through problem solving, negotiation and turn taking. A classic example of the benefits of learning through play. Its lots of fun too!

We will look forward to more water explorations and fun as the summer approaches!



Wise Owls - Casey Caterpillar

During Wise Owls this term the children are engaging in the 'Casey Caterpillar Building Blocks to Literacy and Numeracy Programme'. This programme is designed to build on children's letter recognition knowledge and support them in developing correct letter formation in a playful, relaxed and meaningful way. Our day to day programme at Little Treehouse is rich in literacy

opportunities and our intention is to scaffold the children with these resources further to support their seamless transition to school. The resources that accompany the 'Casey' book are varied and interesting. Each 'treasure box' is filled with an array of items that the teachers will be using to support concepts such as association, rhyming, story telling, memory, matching,

sounds and syllables. The New Zealand early childhood curriculum is evident in these interactions as we turn take, actively listen to each other and participate as part of a group.

Parents can support this programme by providing consistent guidance and language in letter formation at home, details to support this are attached to this newsletter.

 Know Me, Eat Me programme: An internal teaching review on healthy eating and nutrition at kindergarten has resulted in Little Treehouse Kindergarten investing in a food education programme for early childhood centres called Know Me Eat Me where the children will be exploring the food they eat, where it comes from,
