Water Play

With the wonderful summer weather we have started the year with great enthusiasm for water play. Whether it is water and sea creatures in the water trough, our water pump and buckets in the sandpit, watering the garden or simply having fun with the hose and a sprinkler water play provides lots opportunities for children to develop social skills, handeye coordination, and learn about concepts such as measuring, volume, pouring, floating, sinking, full, empty and so on. This play is very transferrable into the home environment too so we encourage you to explore water play options at home.

Garden

With the new year we have replanted our garden which the children have been caring for with enthusiasm. Through our Know Me Eat Me programme the children have learning all zucchinis. We have learnt about their high water science content through experimentation and enjoyed making zucchini fritters. Zucchini's are growing in our garden with daily checks for growth. We have also planted tomatoes which we will be learning about in February.

The children have a huge sense of pride in their garden and really enjoy caring for the plants and watching them grow.



Planned Self-Review focus for 2020

In 2020 our planned self review focus will be surrounding all things relating to transitions, both into and out of our kindergarten community. We will be actively seeking parent input and feedback on these transition processes throughout the year.

Transitions into Kindergarten: We have already begun reflecting on what our transitions into kindergarten look like for our setting. From here we will be researching and investigating as a team how we can improve on our transition into kindergarten processes to best support the child and their whānau as they join and settle into Little Treehouse Kindergarten. We believe the transition into kindergarten is a special time and wish to make this as comfortable for everyone involved as possible to promote the best outcomes for children as they settle, build relationships and develop a sense of belonging within our community.

Transitions out of Kindergarten: We are thrilled with our ongoing visits to St Michaels School and our progress with Casey the Caterpillar building blocks to literacy and numeracy within the Wise Owls programme and how this support our children in preparing for their school transition. This year through our review process, we hope to make connections with other schools in the area to strengthen those relationships, to gain knowledge and to be in a position to better support children transitioning to other schools in our community. We would also like to support parents further with more information around preparing children for school and their school transition.
