Engage Programme

This month we have been continuing to extend our use of the ENGAGE programme games with a focus on developing certain skills such as turn taking, listening, memory, patience, focus, body control and language. We have also being reflecting on our use of intentional language as teachers and ensuring that as a team we are using consistent language that the children understand. As the children have become more familiar with the games we have been observing their use of this intentional language to evidence their learning. Words such as focus, patience, watch, listen, look, remember. Take a look at word clouds on our Engage documentation board for more words we have been using to support this learning. The children have been really enjoying these games and have started asking for their favourites to be repeated. We will continue to use the games as an active part of our programme.

Please ensure children have sunscreen applied each morning on our warmer days. Sunscreen is available at the entrance to the kindergarten.
- Emergency exit: Just a reminder that our emergency exit from the playground into the carpark should only be used for emergency situations and not as an entry or exit from kindy. Thank you for your supporting us with keeping this exit clear.
- Afternoon mat time: We would appreciate support from parents in minimising
- the level of disruption for children during our afternoon mat times by being mindful of the level of noise in the foyer area as children are collected.
- Cutlery: Please ensure that children have any cutlery required to support them in
- eating their lunch independently at kindy. When kindy cutlery is used please return it if it accidentally ends up at home.
