Holidays

Since returning from holiday the children have been sharing with us what they enjoyed doing with their families over the holidays. We have been enjoying listening to their stories and capturing what has been important to them which we are sharing in their portfolios.

Water play

It has been the perfect weather for having fun exploring in the outdoors. Our sandpit and water play are a strong feature of every day. There's nothing more fun than spending time splashing and frolicking in the water on a hot day! While helping us cool there are so many amazing benefits for children's social, emotional and physical development and learning.

Hand-eye coordination is developed as children learn to pour, squeeze and stir water with increasing control. Gross and fine motor skills are strengthened through lifting, pouring and carrying while actions such as squeezing help to develop the small muscles

in a child's hands. Water is perfect for demonstrating mathematical and scientific concepts such as volume and weight. There are also opportunities to explore our senses. Adding materials like sand, ice, soap or slime allows children to explore different textures and experience different temperatures.

Since returning to kindy we have explored water in many ways. We have made ice and gloop to support our sensory play, added water to the sandpit to create volcanoes, lakes, potions and wombat stew and had fun in our mud kitchen. We have enjoyed pouring water between containers and jugs, transferring water using droppers, splashing water with our sprinkler and watering our gardens.
