COMMUNICATION CORNER

Kindness Collective gift giving: Thank you to all of our families who have given generously to our Christmas gift giving initiative with the Kindness Collective. We sponsored a total of 64 children across two early learning centres with amazing gifts as well as donating additional gifts for the Christmas Joy Store. What we achieved as a kindergarten community was truly amazing and will have such a positive impact on the lives of so many children this Christmas.

Early drop off: An early drop off option of 8.30am is available at kindy for a limited number of children at an additional cost of \$4 per day. Casual spaces are often available if needed. We politely request families who have not confirmed the early drop off option to wait until 8.45am to enter kindy as remaining teachers are supporting the kindergarten set up until this time.

15 min car parking: We request that families using the 15 minute carparks ensure that they are able to vacate the carpark within this time restriction. If you are doing a collection at St Michaels School as well as at kindergarten please consider your likely timing. These carparks are allocated for the purpose of ensuring carparking is available for kindy drop off and collections which are expected to be short term.

Sun safety: With summer approaching we have been talking to the children about sun safety and in particular wearing our kindy hats outdoors, applying sunscreen and wearing clothing that protects us from the sun. Please support this learning by ensuring children have sunscreen applied each morning and they are wearing clothing that covers their shoulders to avoid unnecessary sun exposure. Sunscreen is available at the entrance to the kindergarten if required.

Holiday absences: To assist us with our staff planning please let us know if you will be away for any extended time over the Christmas holiday period.

Policies: Review of centre policies is carried out monthly on a rotational basis. This month we reviewed our Health and Safety in Employment and Settling in and Transition policies without any notable changes. All policies are available for review and feedback by our parent community.

Greeting of the Month: This months greeting is Meri Kirihimete, the Maori greeting for Merry Christmas.
